

# EULA Launch Checklist

## Action Checklist — ClearLegalTips.com (2026)

Run this list before your app or software ships with its EULA.

### Step 1 — Draft

- ☐ License grant scope set: devices/seats, personal vs business use
- ☐ Restrictions tuned to the product (copying, reverse engineering, redistribution)
- ☐ Liability cap and warranty disclaimer completed with consumer-law qualifiers
- ☐ Open-source components inventoried; their licenses acknowledged, not claimed

### Step 2 — Check Consistency

- ☐ EULA does not contradict the privacy policy
- ☐ EULA does not contradict the terms of service (if the product has a service side)
- ☐ Meets app-store minimum terms where you distribute
- ☐ Export-compliance line included if the app is distributed internationally

### Step 3 — Wire Up Assent

- ☐ EULA shown in the install / first-run / signup flow
- ☐ Affirmative I Agree action required before use
- ☐ Acceptance log records user, timestamp, and EULA version

### Step 4 — Maintain

- ☐ Version number bumped on every change; old versions archived
- ☐ Re-acceptance triggered for material changes
- ☐ Annual review calendared (law and product both move)
