

Arizona LLC Cost Worksheet (2026)

Every Arizona Corporation Commission fee for forming and keeping an Arizona LLC, checked against the statute and ACC sources, with fill-in lines for your own total

Arizona charges \$50 by statute to file Articles of Organization, or \$85 when you file online with expedited processing, and LLCs file no annual report. Same Day service (optional)	+\$200	Received by 10:00am
2-hour service (optional)	+\$400	Received by 3:00pm
Name reservation (optional)	\$10 (\$45 expedited)	Holds the name 120 days
Publication	\$0 in Maricopa or Pima; newspaper rates elsewhere	Within 60 days after approval
Annual report	\$0 (LLCs file none)	Never
Certificate of Good Standing (optional)	\$10 regular / \$45 instant online	When a bank or another state asks
Statement of change	\$5	Within 30 days of an agent or address change
Amendment to the Articles	\$25	When the Articles need updating
Reinstatement	\$100 plus past-due items	Only within 6 years of dissolution

The recurring calendar (year two onward)

- Every year: \$0 to the Arizona Corporation Commission. LLCs file no annual report.
- At all times: keep a statutory agent on file. Going 60 consecutive days without one is a ground for administrative dissolution under A.R.S. §29-3708(A).
- Any fee the ACC bills: pay it within 60 days of its due date, since late payment is also a dissolution ground.
- Any change of statutory agent or principal address: file a statement of change (\$5) within 30 days.
- If dissolved: reinstatement costs \$100 plus past-due items and is available only within 6 years of dissolution.
